Forms of Bequest

There are a number of ways you can help your specific campus within the EWHS through a bequest in your Will.

Cash Legacy

A specific sum of money given from the value of your estate.

Proportional Bequest

A percentage of the value of your whole estate.

Bequest of Property/Assets

Specific item such as property, shares, jewellery, paintings or your car.

Residual Bequest

The remainder of your estate after providing for family and friends.

While you may draft a Will yourself, it is strongly recommended that you seek advice about the appropriate procedures from your Solicitor, Tax Adviser or a Trustee Company.

Capital Funds & Foundations

Bequests and donations made to Birchip, Charlton and Wycheproof campuses will be deposited in a campus specific capital fund, administered and overseen by the East Wimmera Health Service and the Board of Management.

Bequests and donations made to Donald and St Arnaud campuses can be deposited into a campus specific capital fund (described above) or into a Foundation that is administered and overseen by independent community trustees. The choice is yours and further information is available to assist your decision making.

East Wimmera Health Service

The East Wimmera Health Service (EWHS), was established under Section 64A of the Health Services Act 1998 on 1 July 1999 with the amalgamation of the former East Wimmera Health Service (Donald and St Arnaud) with the Birchip Bush Nursing Hospital, Charlton Bush Nursing Hospital and the Wycheproof & District Hospital. This amalgamation formed the East Wimmera Health Service, so named because of it's location to the extreme east of the Wimmera Plains.

EWHS provides health care to a population catchment of approximately 12,000 people, which includes the townships and districts of Birchip, Charlton, Donald, St Arnaud and Wycheproof.

The five campuses have a long standing reputation for quality patient care provided by highly committed, competent and compassionate staff. Dedicated and diligent hospital Auxillaries and Foundations provide extra equipment which enhances the standard of care enjoyed by all.
